Route to Ostromecko

Toruń (Old Town Square) • Unisław Ostromecko • Toruń

Distance: 80 km Time: 4-6 h

The route is traced in its most parts through separated bicycle paths, at times with broken stone surface (the Unisław – Ostromecko distance). The distance between Ostromecko and Toruń goes along the Vistula Cycling Route markings. On the way there is a possibility to turn towards Bierzgłowski Castle and Barbarka.

ATTRACTIONS

- Barbarka a forest settlement with an ecology education centre, rope park, playground and a little cafe in an old forester's lodge.
- **Bierzgłowski Castle** one of the smallest preserved medieval Teutonic castles, beautifully located on the hill overlooking the Vistula proglacial valley.
- **Skłudzewo** with a nineteenth century palace-park complex with a neogothic manor house - currently the office of Fundacja Piękniejszego Świata (Beautiful World Foundation).
- Unisław a town located on the border of Lower Vistula River Valley (the most beautiful view of the Valley is to be seen from the nearby village Gzin Górny).
- Ostromecko a palace-park complex includes two palaces: barogue one of around 1730 and a classicistic one of 1849.



Route to Ciechocinek

Toruń (Old Town Square) • Ciechocinek Nieszawa • Osiek nad Wisła • Toruń

Distance: 77 km Time: 4-6 h

The tour mainly goes with the Vistula Cycling Route, at times with troublesome ground and broken stone roads, it also includes a ferry crossing. A mountain or trekking bicycle is recommended. NOTE: The ferry in Nieszawa operates only in the summer season but it may be temporarily closed because of low tide on Vistula - current information on ferry service can be checked on the website: www.nieszawa.pl.

ATTRACTIONS

- **Ciechocinek** a famous health resort with spring park, water drinking place and the unique, biggest in Europe, graduation towers used for brine vaporisation.
- Nieszawa a charming little town with St. Jadwiga Śląska Gothic church from the fifteenth century, a museum dedicated to the architect and painter Stanisław Noakowski and Franciscan monastery and church.
- Osiek nad Wisłą a village situated in Toruń Valley with a picturesque forest lake and sandy beach.

The tour goes mostly through dedicated bicycle paths. Past Sławkowo there is a possibility to turn in the direction of Kamionki Lake (7 km one way). The tour ends on the crossroad with voivodship road No. 553 beyond Pigża, from there it is possible to return to Toruń on a cycling path (+11 km) visiting Barbarka on the way or to continue the trip through Unisław, Ostromecko, Skłudzewo (+70 km)

Route to Chełmża

Distance: 44 km (+11 km to Toruń)

Toruń (Old Town Square)

Chełmża • Pigża

Time: 2-3 h (+1h)

ATTRACTIONS

- Chełmża a historic town beautifully situated on the lake shore. It's main attractions are a medieval co-cathedral and a bathing area and sandy beach.
- Kamionki Lake a charming lake surrounded by a forest, a big beach, guarded bathing area, numerous gastronomic places in the summer season.
- Barbarka a forest settlement with an ecology education centre, rope park, playground and a little cafe in an old forester's lodge.

A short tour of Bydgoskie Przedmieście, located west from the Old Town. Since the end of the nineteenth century, it has been a prestigious neighbourhood where wealthy middle class people lived. A series of grand tow houses and public utility buildings were erected then there, a park and a botanic garden were created.

Route to Nieszawka

Toruń (Old Town Square) • Wielka Nieszawka

Distance: 6 km (one way) Time: 30 min

A short tour leading mainly through the cycling route. The initial part of the tour goes through J. Piłsudski bridge from where Dybowski Castle ruins can be seen.

ATTRACTIONS

• Dybowski Castle ruins - the castle was erected in the fifteenth century by the king Władysław Jagiełło on the left bank of the Vistula River, across from Teutonic Toruń.

• Oleder Ethnographic Park - the reconstructed fragment of Oleder village situated on the Vistula from the turn of nineteenth and twentieth centuries. A Mennonite cemetery in the area of the Park.

5 Route to Kepa Bazarowa

Toruń (Old Town Square) • viewing point on Kepa Bazarowa Distance: 2,5 km (one way) • Time: 15 min

A very short tour to the viewing point on the Vistula left bank from where there is a picturesque view of Toruń Old Town. The viewing spot is located on the Vistula island – Kepa Bazarowa. A part of the island is taken up by a nature reservation with a willow and poplar

6 Route to Bydgoskie Przedmieście

Toruń (Old Town Square) • Bydgoskie Przedmieście Distance: 7 km (loop) • Time: 30 min
